2. Generally, the gardens are open from 9:00 to 17:00. (Some garden hours may vary. Please refer to each garden column.)
3. Please enjoy the garden quietly to avoid disturbing the neighbors.
4. Please do not touch the plants or anything else.
5. Please do not ring the doorbell when entering or leaving the garden.
6. Please refrain from using the lavatory.
7. Please refrain from visiting in groups of more than three people.
8. Please refrain from eating and drinking during your visit.
9. Please follow the owner's instructions when taking photos.
10. The owner may not always respond to you.
11. Please do not enter the garden with your pet.
12. Generally, there are no parking lots available.
13. Please take any garbage back with you.
14. Please confirm that the garden is open via the OPEN/CLOSED sign.
15. Hours may differ due to Covid-19.

1 Morita Open Garden

From February through September on the 1st and 3rd Thursdays of every month, the Minroi-mura garden is opened for visitors to come in and explore the aquatic habitat found inside the garden. Frogs, killifish, and lots of aquatic plants can be seen!

The area looked like pre-modernization. The garden has seasonal wild flowers, waterways inhabited by multicolored, elegant carp, and a remote mountain village-esque tea house. Escape the hustle and bustle of everyday life by relaxing in the greenery, comforted by the sounds of trickling streams, the sound of the wind rustling the trees, singing birds, and steam engine whistles.

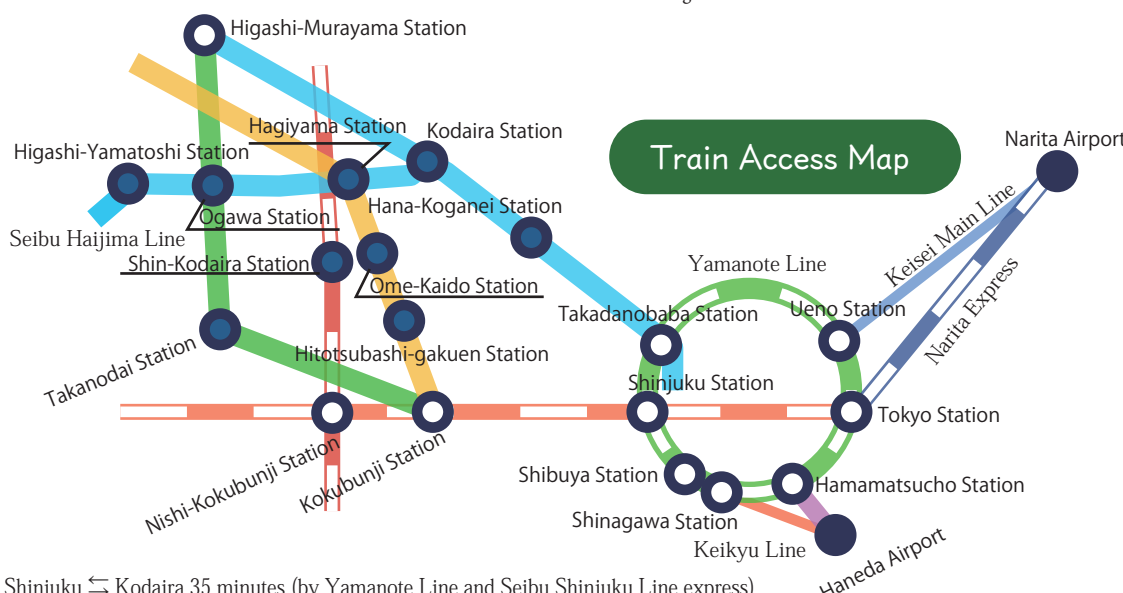

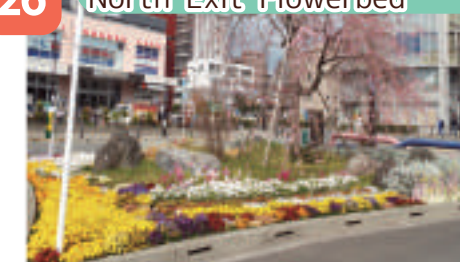
